

New Nursing Student Roles: What's Changing?

- We are streamlining the nursing student roles
- Fewer roles to choose from
- Less overall training time required for students and instructors
- Reduce redundancy of training, improve security access points and increase efficiency
- Ready in time for use in the Fall 2025 semester

PRACTICUM SPECIFIC ILT

These course will provide information regarding the workflows that pertain to the specific practicum that the nursing student will be attending.

Current times on slide are estimated, however none will exceed one full day of training.









Final Practicum and AHS hires

- Some nursing students in their final practicum may not need to repeat training to obtain the full staff role but some will.
 - areas where they wouldn't need to retrain is Ambulatory/Outpatient areas, Continuing Care, Home Care, Public Health
 - areas where the student will be required to take full staff training are Inpatient areas and Emergency Departments (both rural and urban) and all specialty areas (see graphic on this slide)
- Training previously obtained with student roles will not transition over if they become employed with AHS; this is because we have removed some content they would need as staff
- Final practicum students who are in specialty areas will continue to use staff nursing roles

Scheduling Principles

- Since January of this year, we have had to reschedule 170 classes with 40% of them needing a new session to be created just for 1 or a few students
- This leads to a major surge in resource
- The main cause of rescheduling are:
 - 1) unavailable dates were not entered properly in HSPnet
 - 2) student scheduling conflict
 - Other notable causes were location changes, request cancelled by school or HSPnet information was not correct

Scheduling Principles Cont...

What we would like to do about it....

- Need to have scheduling details confirmed 30 days prior to placement start date. This has not been met and causes delays in placement and rework with the scheduling process
- S/A Listing Reports to Connect Care Learning for processing no later than 30 days prior to placement start date
- Confirmed unavailable training dates information needs to be included (i.e. send dates unavailable vs 1-2 days available as scheduling needs flexibility to schedule)
- Rescheduling of training will only be accommodated for family emergencies, court date appearances, etc...
