



UPDATES TO PROVINCIAL ADULT UROLOGY REFERRAL PATHWAY

February 18, 2025

- Link to the Provincial Male LUTS Primary Care Clinical Pathway added to the front page and the Lower Urinary Tract Symptoms (LUTS) reason for referral

January 24, 2025

- Updated process in Central Zone for Testicular Mass and Acute/Urteteric stone

January 20, 2025

- New Clinical Pathway added: Provincial Adult Gender-Affirming Care Primary Care Clinical Pathway
- Process for Orchidectomy (Gender-affirming) changed to reflect the new clinical pathway

January 3, 2025

- Updated process for urology reasons for referral in Calgary that previously directed referring providers to seek non-urgent phone advice

October 24, 2024
