Corrections Outbreak Checklist 2

Roles and Responsibilities

AHS Infection Control Practitioner/designate or IPC Medical Lead

This checklist outlines the roles and responsibilities of the AHS Infection Control Practitioner/designate or IPC medical lead before, during and after an outbreak. These actions help protect everyone at the centre and ensure a coordinated response.

Task/Responsibility	Timeline / Frequency ⁱ
Maintain familiarity with and present annual HCW/staff education on the Guide for Outbreak Prevention & Control in Provincial Correctional Centres.	Ongoing
Promote staff awareness of outbreak measures, including when and how to report symptomatic clients to the AHS Public Health Outbreak team.	Ongoing
Advise the AHS Site Health Services Manager/designate of required supplies for outbreak management (such as PPE and specimen collection kits).	Ongoing
 Assist in providing training for specimen collection as requested by the AHS Site Health Services Manager/designate. 	Ongoing
Complete initial notification following the internal notification process if requested by the AHS Site Health Services Manager/designate or the AHS Public Health Outbreak team.	Immediate
 Coordinate the implementation of infection prevention and control measures for symptomatic or confirmed clients. Do not wait until there is a confirmed pathogen. Ensure routine and additional precautions are in place and collaborate with CSD staff to medically isolate symptomatic clients. Post additional precaution signage. 	Ongoing



Task/Responsibility	Timeline / Frequency ⁱ
 Coordinate the collection of outbreak specimens when requested by the AHS Site Health Services Manager/designate. 	As required
Obtain reports on the clinical status of confirmed or symptomatic clients. Work with staff to identify newly symptomatic clients.	Ongoing
Direct the implementation of control measures for complex outbreaks if recommended by the AHS Public Health Outbreak team.	As required
Participate in the outbreak management team.	As required
Participate in a post outbreak debriefing to review and evaluate outbreak management and make recommendations for improvement.	Post outbreak

i Immediate: Compete task as soon as possible throughout the outbreak
 Ongoing: Complete task throughout the outbreak period
 As required: Complete task according to need (as necessary)
 Post outbreak: Complete after the outbreak is ended
