

## Types of vaccine providers facilities may use for the Outreach Immunization Program

Provider type	Description	Who they can immunize	Important notes on use
<b>Community pharmacy</b>	A pharmacy, usually in a retail setting, that provides pharmaceutical drugs including certain immunizations (e.g., CareRx, London Drugs, Medicine Shoppe)	Residents and staff	<p>To use this option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You need to contact the immunizing pharmacist <b>before</b> completing the Survey.</li> <li>The <a href="#">Pharmacy Outreach Immunization Worksheet</a> can be used to gather the information required.</li> </ul>
<b>In-house provider</b>	An RN, LPN, or in-house pharmacist <b>employed by your facility</b> who provides immunizations at your facility	Residents and staff	<p>To use this option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The RN, LPN, or in-house pharmacist need to complete specified orientation resources through AHS.</li> <li>Your facility must be able to order vaccines, document vaccine data, and meet AHS vaccine, storage and handling guidelines.</li> </ul>
<b>Alberta Health Services (AHS) Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) or Covenant Occupational Health and Safety</b>	A facility RN, LPN, paramedic or pharmacist employed by your facility who has been designated as your facility's Site Champion	Staff only	<p>To use this option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Site Champions will need to complete specified training through WHS or OHS.</li> </ul>

(OHS) Site Champions			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You will need to have an <b>additional provider</b> for your <b>residents</b>.</li> </ul>
Provider type	Description	Who they can immunize	Important notes on use
<b>AHS Public Health</b>	An RN or LPN <b>employed at an AHS Community Health Centre</b> who comes out to provide immunizations at your facility	Residents and staff	<p>To use this option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AHS Public Health is <b>only available</b> to facilities who <b>do not have</b> another immunization provider available to them.</li> <li>You will need to contact the PPO Team to discuss further. The PPO Team can assist you with identifying the most appropriate immunization provider for your facility.</li> </ul>
<b>Other</b>	<p>The immunization provider for your facility does not meet the definition of the first four options. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AHS on-site pharmacy</li> <li>Private occupational health company</li> </ul>	Residents and staff	<p>To use this option:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You will need to contact the PPO Team to discuss further.</li> </ul>
