



Printing Immunizations


Printer Icon in the Footer

At the bottom of the Summary page, there is a Printer Icon which allows for two different types of printing; **Screen** and **Report**.



Screen



By selecting **Screen** and  your local printer will print the exact view the user is seeing (ie. entire EMR **Summary** page).



Report

Report will generate an EMR Report containing relevant client information based on information entered.

1. Select **Report** and .
2. The **Report Format** field has a drop down arrow which contains various reports. Access to reports is dependent on your location & care area. For this example, we will select the **MEDS** report
3. Indicate the time frame required, in the **From/Thru Date & Time** fields.



4. Select **View** to view the report
5. To print the report, select the print icon  in the header at the top of the page
