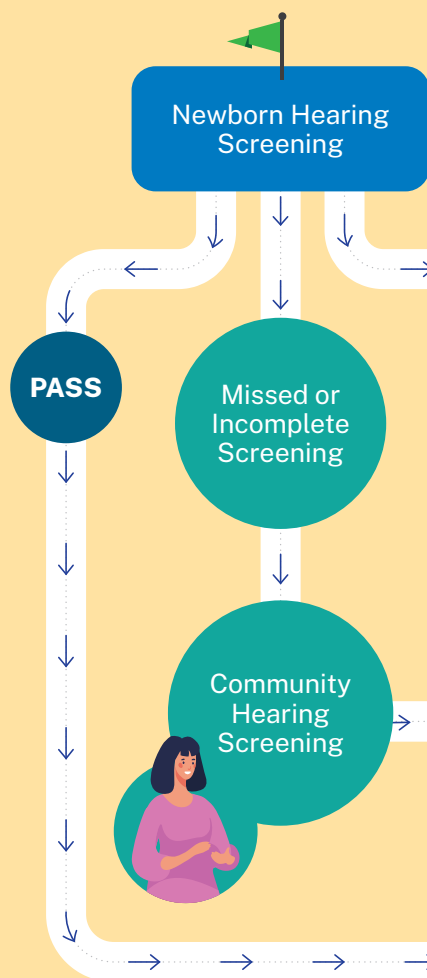


# My Baby's Early Hearing Journey

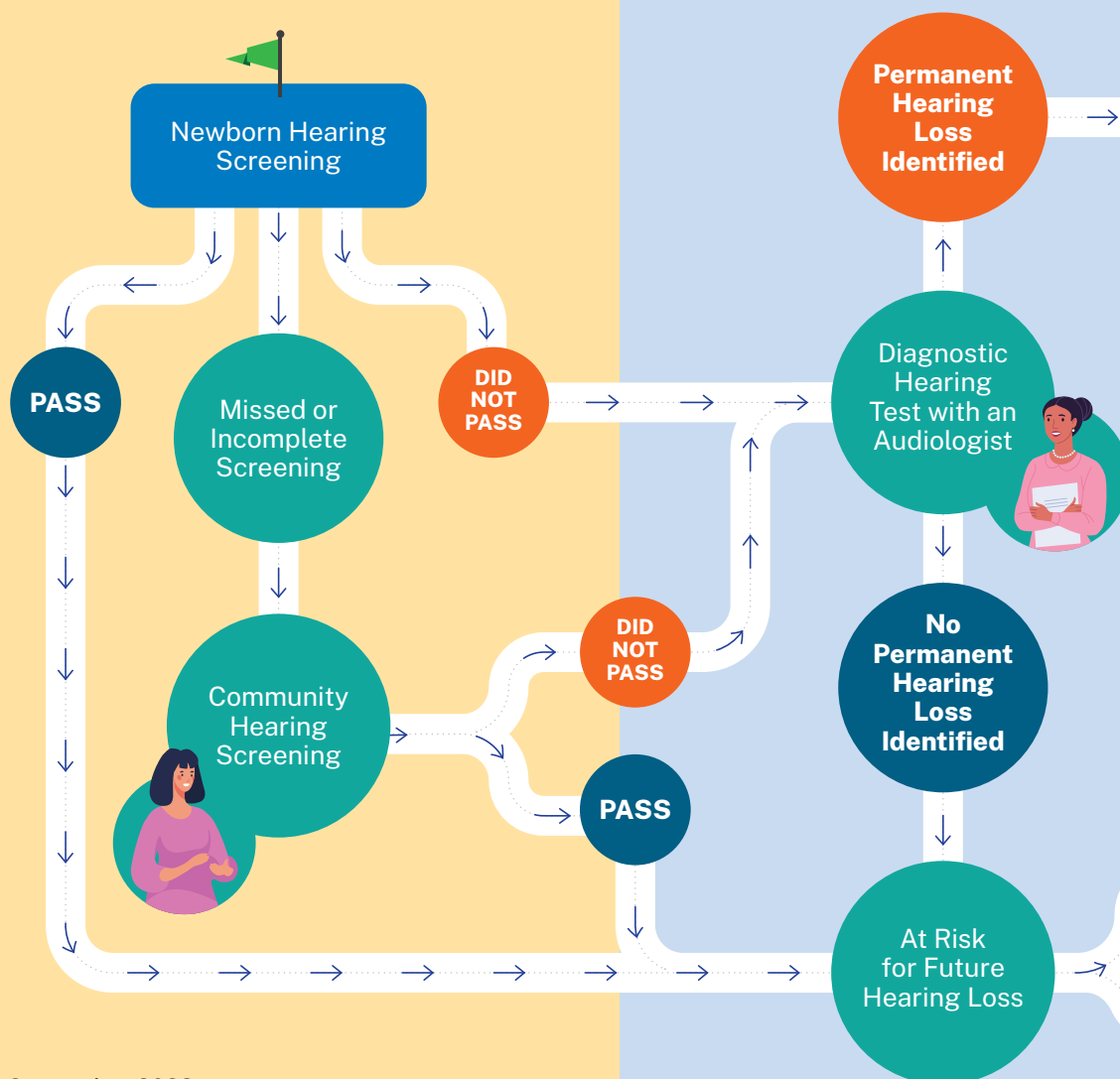
## Birth to 1 Month

After the birth of your baby, you will be offered hearing screening for your baby. Your baby's hearing is important for child and brain development. It's best if your baby is screened by 1 month of age.



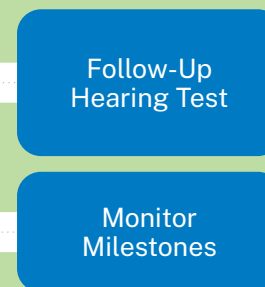
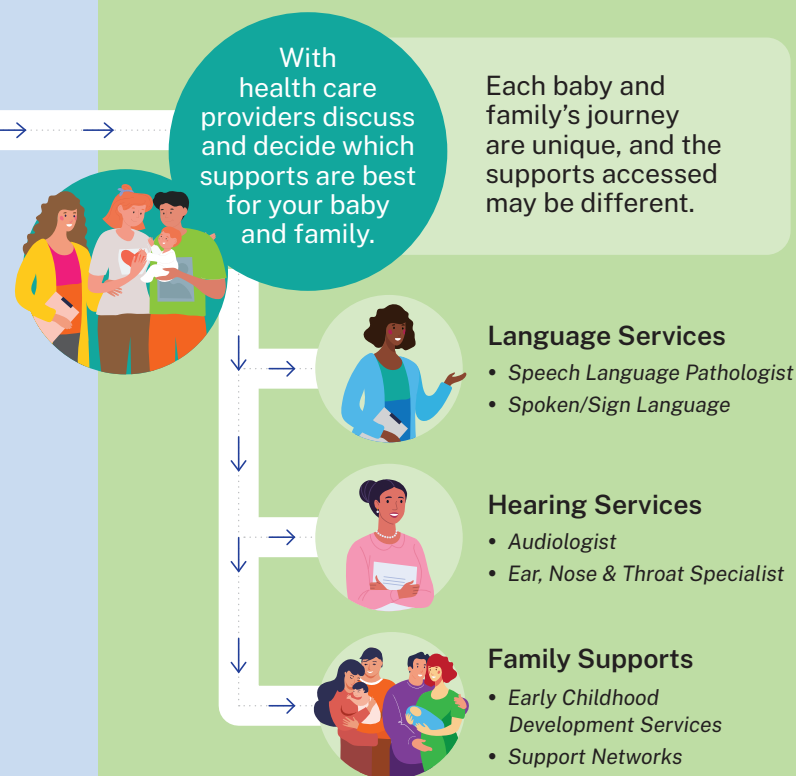
## 1 to 3 Months

When hearing loss is found early, your baby and family can get the support you need sooner. It's best if your baby's diagnostic hearing test happens by 3 months of age.



## 3 to 6 Months and Beyond

Early access to hearing loss supports is important for your baby's healthy development and future learning. It's best if your baby starts support services by 6 months of age.
