Why am I being directed to Alberta Health?

Alberta Health is responsible for administering the Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan and aspects of patient identification.

Why do I need to update my baby's health information?

It is important that your baby's health information is up to date so that there is a complete and reliable electronic health record for your baby.

What information is in my baby's electronic health record?

Medical information such as lab results, dispensed prescriptions and transcribed clinical reports are saved in health records. Health records are an important tool for health service providers in Alberta.
