Outcome:

- 98 per cent of patients managed virtually by Calgary zone primary care in the community and didn't need to be admitted to acute care.
- Have used this same integration approach with subsequent outbreaks.

Tools used or created:

- Calgary Rural PCN used the [Calgary Zone COVID-19 Pathway](#) to assess and care for patients in the community.
- A data hub was created to send positive results from lab to PCNs in a secure and timely method.
- Alberta International Medical Graduate Association created [75 videos in 19 languages](#) that provided information about COVID-19 used by employers, community agencies and PCNs
- Alberta International Medical Graduate Association created [webinars](#) for ethnic communities within High River with ethnocultural organizations.
