Outbreak Reporting: Congregate living sites with possible respiratory outbreaks (two symptomatic cases within a 7 day period) or possible gastrointestinal outbreaks (two symptomatic cases within a 48 hour period) must make an initial report to the AHS Population Public Health Support Team (**PPHST**), phone: **1-844-343-0971**.
