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### **Adverse Events Following Immunization:**

**Note:** The above report form and phone number are for Health Care Practitioners to report the adverse events of their patients/residents/clients only. If you are a Health Care Practitioner and needing to report your own adverse event, please call Health Link (811).

The South Zone Medical Officer of Health will assess the AEFIs, in collaboration with the Provincial AEFI team, with recommendations communicated to the health care provider and their patient.

### **Vaccines for Post-Exposure Prophylaxis and COVID-19 Vaccine:**

Vaccines that are clinically indicated for post-exposure prophylaxis should be administered (e.g., tetanus-containing vaccine, rabies vaccine), regardless of spacing to COVID-19 vaccine.
