OPIOID POISONING SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS

Call 911 if one or more signs are present.



Slow or No Breathing



Unresponsive (Can't Wake Them)



Stiff body or seizure-like movement



Choking or Throwing Up



Gurgling or Snoring Sounds



Blue Lips or Nails



Narrow (Constricted) Pupils



Pale Face



Cold and Damp Skin

Avoid using alone and carry naloxone.
