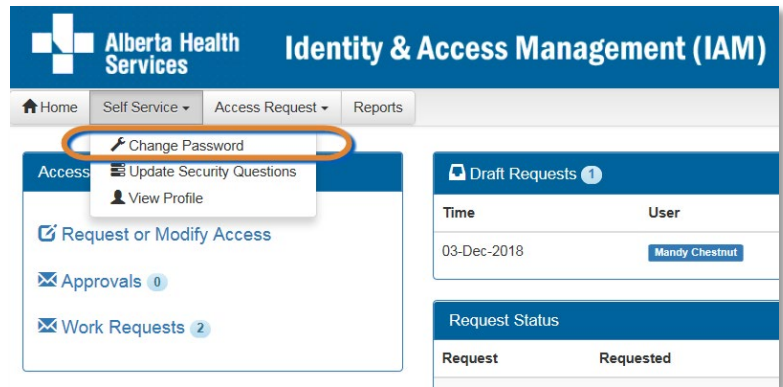
Change your AHS Network Password

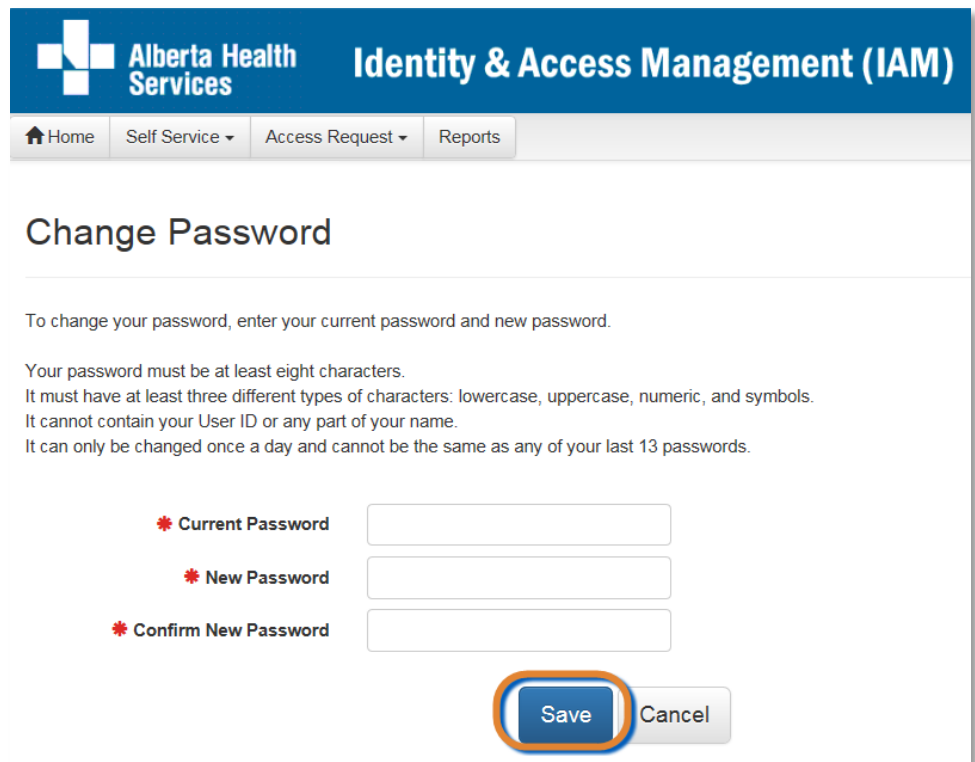

Reset your AHS Network Password

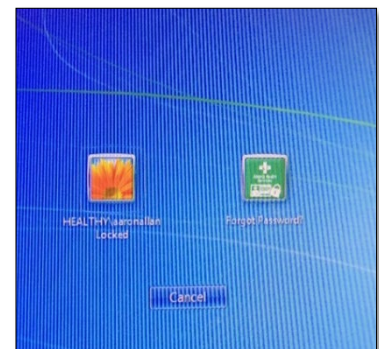

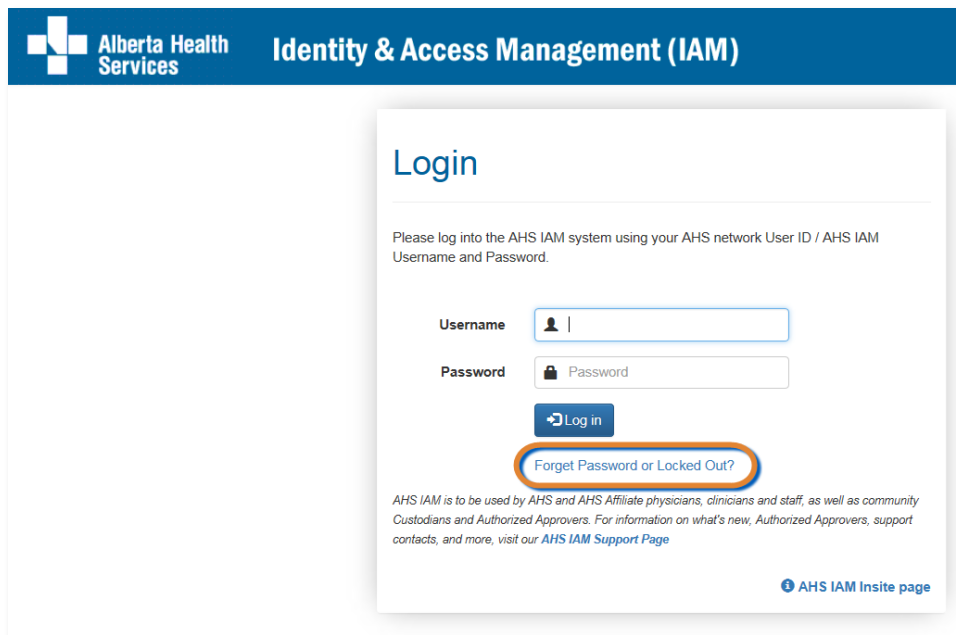
