Before you change your password

The Self-Serve Password Reset (SSPR) tool uses Microsoft Azure Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) as its primary authentication method. Make sure you have [set up your MFA authentication methods](#).

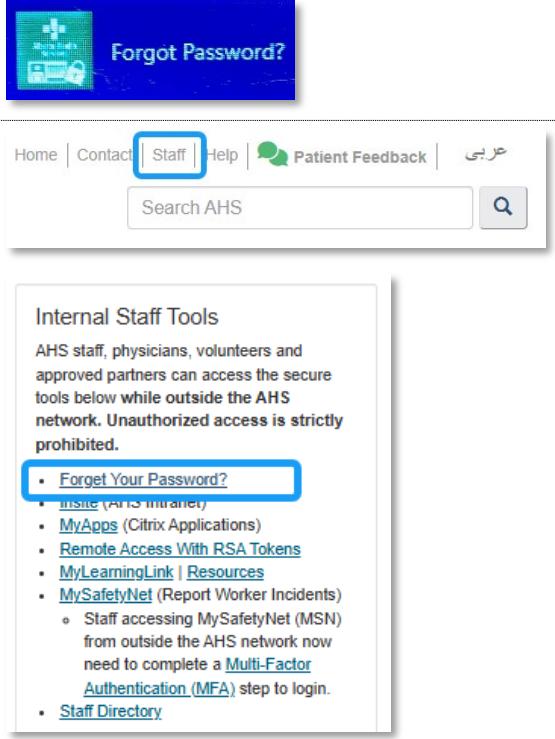

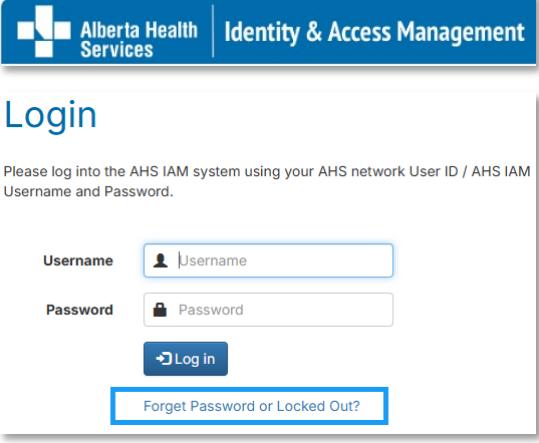
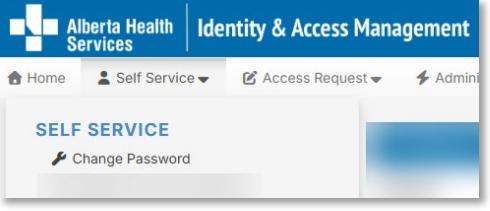
Reasons to change your password

- **You have forgotten your password** and need a new one.
- **You know your password** and believe it has been compromised, or you just want to change it.
- **You have locked your AHS Network account** after too many unsuccessful login attempts. Skip the 15-minute wait period and reset your password.
- **You like to do it yourself** and it saves a call to the [AHS IT Service Desk & Solution Centre](#). They are always there if you get stuck, but saving time is good for everyone.

Step 1 – Where is the Forget Password? or Change Password link?

There are at least 5 places to find Forget Password? or Change Password links. Choose whichever method is most convenient to you.

Step 2 – Enter your Username

ENTER your Username

IAM will detect if you have Microsoft Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) capability.

If you do, you will be prompted to choose your preferred MFA method. Go to Step 3.

If you don't, you'll be prompted to answer your IAM Security Profile questions. Go to Step 4.

Forget Password or Locked Out?

Once you enter your username below, IAM will detect if you have a Microsoft Azure Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) capability. If you do, you will be automatically redirected to the MFA screen to complete your authentication and change your network password. You will no longer be able to use your AHS IAM Security Profile questions / answers.

Make sure you have your MFA methods set up.

If IAM detects you do not have MFA capability, you will continue to use your AHS IAM Security Profile questions / answers to reset your network password.

Make sure you have your IAM Security Profile set up.

Change Password

To change your password, enter your new password and confirm it.

- Your password must be at least eight characters.
- It must have at least three different types of characters: lowercase, uppercase, numeric, and symbols.
- It cannot contain your User ID or any part of your name.
- It can only be changed once a day and cannot be the same as any of your last 13 passwords.
