

Expected Death in the Home Form 20519 Ordering Instructions

The *Patient's Death in the Home Care Setting (Patient Receiving Home Care Services in Private Home or Seniors' Lodge) Guideline* provides guidance for Home Care health care professionals and Home Care health care providers on how to manage an expected or unexpected death of a patient (i.e. a child or an adult) receiving Home Care services (from any team) who is residing in either a private home or seniors' lodge. The Guideline also has a section with guidance for Home Care staff on preparation for possible or imminent expected death of a patient receiving Home Care services.

An *Expected Death in the Home* form, provides consistent instructions to families and ensures that service providers have the information they need when involved with an expected death at home (including seniors' lodge) of a Home Care patient.

- Page 1 – information for service providers; required; white copy on Home Care chart and yellow copy in Green Sleeve
- Page 2 – information for family/ next of kin; optional; recommend placing single white copy in Green Sleeve
