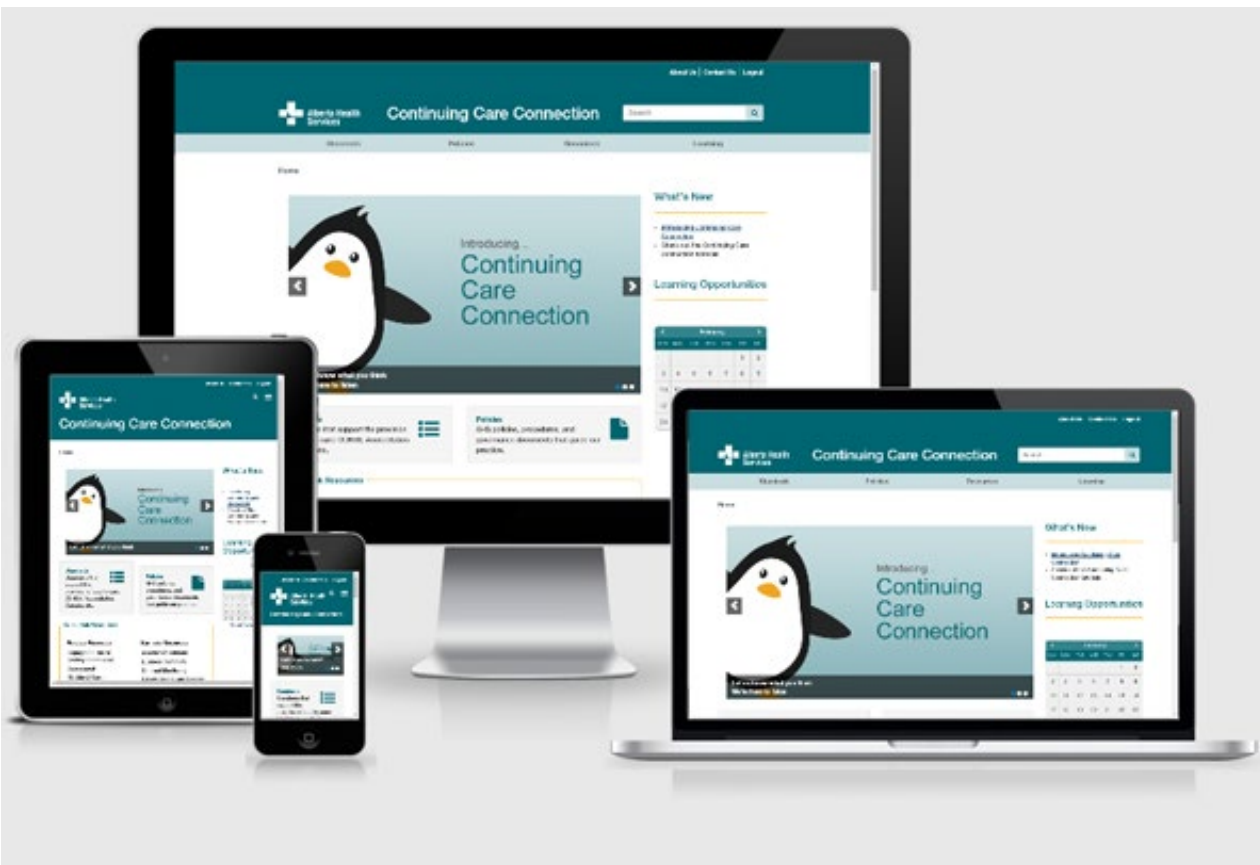

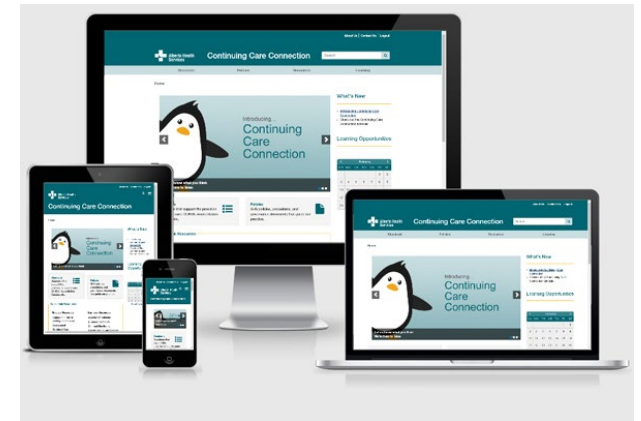
Welcome to the Continuing CareConnection

The CCC will provide users with:

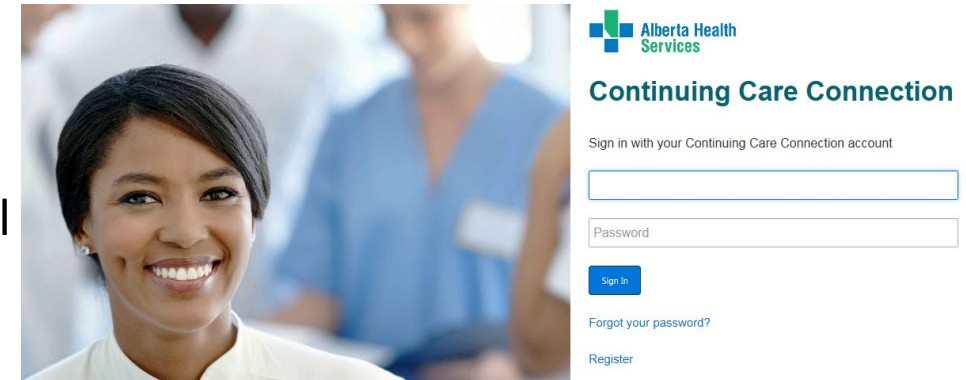
- Improved usability

Registration

New Users:

- When first arriving at **connection.ahs.ca**, a new user will come to a Login/Registration page
- New user must click on Register for the CCC, complete all mandatory fields, then submit their profile for approval

 - Email
 - Location
 - Occupation/Role
 - Supervisor Name/Phone Number/Email
- The new user registration is automatically approved
- New user will be able to logon to the CCC using their new credentials

Continuing Care Health Service Standards (CCHSS)

The Ministry of Health is committed to supporting the delivery of Quality Health Care to Albertans in the continuing care system through the application of the Continuing Care Health Service Standards (CCHSS).

The CCHSS are a legislated requirement of Operators pursuant to the Nursing Homes General Regulation under the Nursing Homes Act, the Co-ordinated Home Care Program Regulation under the Public Health Act and pursuant to a Ministerial Directive under the Regional Health Authorities Act.

The CCHSS set the minimum requirements that Publicly Funded Operators in the continuing care system must comply with the provision of Health Care.
