- Flexible three-year term, with the option to renew

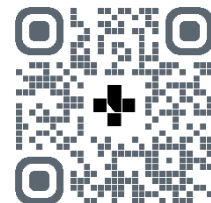


**To ensure the diversity of Alberta's population is reflected in PFAC as best as possible, we're currently looking for individuals who:**
