




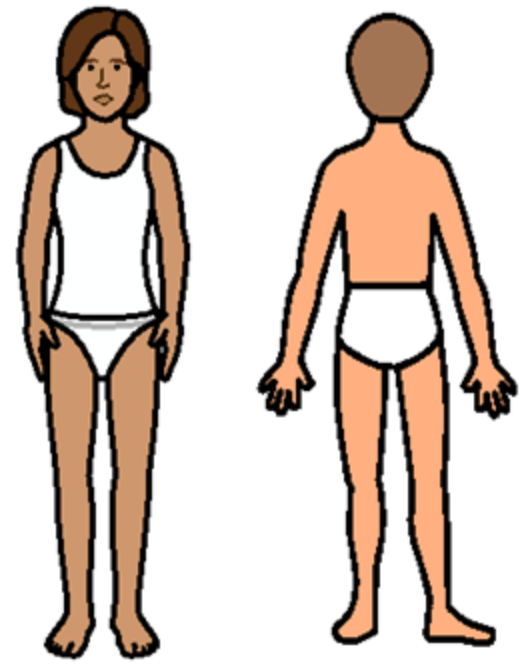


































This board allows patients to communicate by pointing to a message or letter. If the person is unable to touch the board, establish a way for them to signal "Yes" (e.g. looking up for yes, nodding or a long eye blink). Then, point to each row and ask "Is it in this row?". Wait for the patient to signal "Yes" before asking the next row. Next, go through each item in the selected row and wait for the patient to indicate "yes" for their choice. They do not need to indicate "no" for undesired options.
