## **OR – PPE Donning**

## Recommendations for operating room staff & physicians. Ideally followed & completed with a PPE Buddy.

You **MUST** don a bouffant head cover and remove all personal items (including pagers & cellphones) **BEFORE** entering a semi-restricted space.

1.	Hand Hygiene	<ul> <li>Clean your hands before accessing supplies</li> <li>If hands look and feel clean, use ABHR</li> <li>If hands are dirty or sticky, wash with soap and water; must dry with paper towel</li> </ul>
2.	N95 Respirator	<ul> <li>Stretch the top and bottom straps before placing respirator on your face</li> <li>Cup respirator in your hand, inside facing up</li> <li>Position it under your chin, with the nose piece up</li> <li>Secure straps around your head so respirator stays in place</li> <li>Use both hands to mold the nose piece around the bridge of your nose</li> <li>Fit check</li> </ul>
3.	Eye Protection	Don face shield or goggles as usual
4.	Hand Hygiene	<ul> <li>If scrubbing, perform normal scrub</li> <li>Non-scrub personnel DO NOT need to scrub</li> </ul>
5.	Gown	Securely tie all three sets of ties as usual
6.	Gloves	<ul> <li>Wear gloves over gown cuffs</li> <li>Gown cuffs are not fluid-resistant</li> </ul>
7.	2 <sup>nd</sup> Pair of Gloves	<ul> <li>Don second pair of gloves over first pair</li> <li>Change gloves as needed</li> <li>Never use ABHR on gloves</li> <li>Change gloves post-intubation</li> <li>Discard in garbage</li> </ul>
