## Low Income Cutoff Information

If the client has completed Section B, use the table below to determine if they are eligible for funded physiotherapy services.

Use the total annual taxable income for the client and their spouse/partner, based on the most recent tax year Notice of Assessment.

If the total annual taxable income of the family is equal to or less than the amounts indicated below, the client is eligible to receive AHS funded physiotherapy services:
