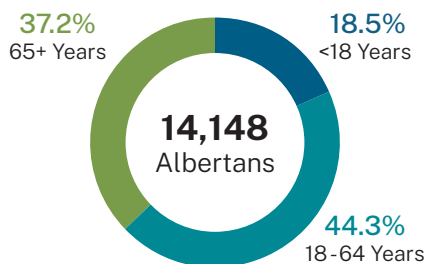

## Clinical Trials by the Numbers

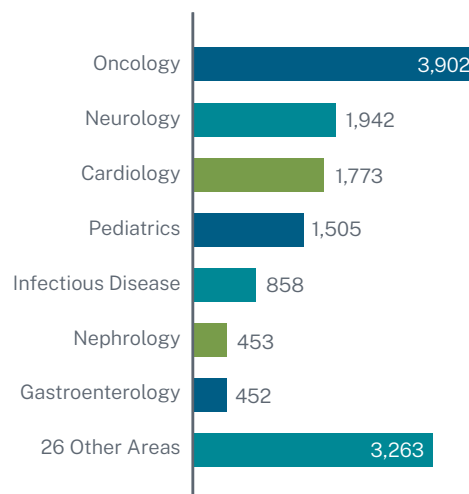
January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2023
