

## The Alberta Addiction and Mental Health Research Hub AMH COVID-19 Seed Grant 2020 Application Template

Please submit a word document or pdf containing the following to the **Addiction and Mental Health (AMH) Research Hub**. We will accept 4 pages maximum, excluding references and Biosketch. Word limits will be enforced, addenda and appendices will not be accepted.

1. Principle Investigator (PI) information:
  - Name
  - Organization and department
  - Email address
  - Phone number
2. Canadian Institutes of Health Research Biosketch CV for the PI.
3. Describe how the application addresses or explores current issues in addiction or mental health arising from COVID-19, and the importance of the work. (maximum 300 words).
4. A research proposal, including the project title, methodology, and anticipated outcomes (maximum 600 words).
5. Explain the future impact of this work, implications for practice, and how the PI plans to build on this work with future funding opportunities (e.g., tri-council, etc). (maximum 300 words)
6. A budget for the project, including justification and relevant details for the requested amount. Proposals may be funded up to \$15,000, and proposed budgets must be within the allotted amount. If the budget is outside the allotted amount, additional information must be provided about how this amount will be covered from other sources and whether that additional funding is already secured.
7. A timeline for the research project, addressing potential barriers and facilitators (maximum 300 words).
8. A team list outlining the research team and positions/affiliations. The list should include the PI, research support, and any other stakeholders (e.g., healthcare operations, people with lived experience, etc.) Given the quick turnaround with this grant and associated timelines, please indicate whether each team member has already been engaged, or is proposed. Please see the table below for an example.
