

UAH Special Isolation Unit  
Activation - Adult Patient Presents at Location Other than UAH

Patient screened /determined to have travel history, possible contact and identified symptoms to prompt isolation

- Presenting area activates unit-specific isolation procedure

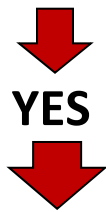

If patient is an obstetric/gynecological, the physician on-call for obstetrics/gynecology contacted via the Royal Alexandra Switchboard: 780-735-4111

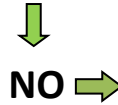

**To prepare for patient arrival at UAH, Critical Care Manager at UAH contacts:**

- ED Charge RN (780-407-6006) – notify of impending patient arrival to Decontamination room
- GSICU Charge RN (780-407-3274)
- Respiratory Manager (780-407-6191)
- Burn Unit Charge RN (780-407-6149) **\*\*\*5C3 Charge RN 780-407-6184 (if 3C2 SIU unavailable)**  
GSICU and Burns Charge RNs will initiate appropriate specific SIU procedures
- Manager-on-call for Pediatrics
- EMS (780-735-0812) for determine probably time of arrival at UAH
- IPC at UAH – notify of SIU activation

**Critical Care Manager arrives at the SIU location and utilizes that space as the command- centre to coordinate all activation activities and phone calls.**
