

Protective Services – UAH SIU Activation Process

Purpose:

To safely guide Special Isolation Unit team, transporting suspected Ebola patient, through ED to Special Isolation Unit (SIU) on Level 3 reducing risk of accidental contamination and transmission of disease.

Process:

- Critical Care Manager contacts Protective Services Team Leader-on-Duty (7-7777) indicating the SIU has been activated
 - If patient has presented to UAH ED, Critical Care Manager to give estimated time when SIU will be ready to for patient transport to SIU
 - If the patient is arriving via EMS, give estimated time of arrival
- 2. Team Leader-on-Duty contacts the 2 officers assigned to patient transfer
 - Assigns one officer to Level 1 (outside area where patient is isolated in ED or at the Decontamination Room)
 - Assigns second officer to Level 3 outside Elevator 37 (or other elevator)
 - Reviews process with both officers

Transferring Special Isolation Patient to SIU:

Protective Services will open **ALL** doors and clear path for SIU team.

Protective Services **DOES NOT** touch the stretcher or elevator controls **Level 1**

- 1. When ready to start move to SIU, officer will contact Facilities Operations Centre via radio Channel 1 to have **Elevator 37** (aka the Megavator) to be sent to Level 1
 - The elevator 'times out' in approximately 10 minutes if team has not arrived at elevator, may need to contact Facilities again.
- 2. Once team on elevator, officer will contact Facilities via radio to send Elevator 37 to Level 3
- 3. Level 1 Protective Services officer to remain stationed at Elevator 37 area (Environmental Services to clean elevator before return to regular service)

Level 3

- 1. Once SIU team exits elevator, SIU team will inform officer if elevator clear or contaminated
- 2. Officer leads team, clearing path of all personnel especially at areas of connecting corridors
- 3. Officer opens doors to OR corridor (3A4.00Z) and verbally warns any personnel to stand clear
- 4. Officer opens first door to SIU, steps into corridor (by sink) and activates second door to SIU
- 5. Officer now de-gloves, performs hand hygiene at sink and leaves SIU
- 6. Officer calls Team Leader-on-Duty to notify that patient has been arrived at SIU
