Why Standardize Outpatient Treatment Visits for Clients with Fracture & Orthopedic Surgery?

Clients know what to expect from services	Clients and staff have shared expectations
Decrease variability in practice	Approach to care varied between therapists
Implement evidenced-based services	Supportive of practice guidelines
Musculoskeletal prioritized by Allied Health Operations	Chronic wait lists and wait times – could the Standard help?
Align with new Rehabilitation Model of Care	1 of 18 early adopter teams in the province (2017-2018)

Lessons Learned

Client experience remained high while visits were fewer


Implementing the Standard can impact practice in other services and programs

Trend to reduced wait time and wait lists may be partially attributable to Standardization

Consider if efficiencies gained leads to reinvestment

Outcomes – Qualitative

- Beginning: "Will a standardized approach meet the needs of our complex clients?"
- End: Clients did well with spaced visits + focus on education and self-management
- Staff <u>and</u> clients liked outcome measures
- Functional goal setting more deliberate: "I want to wash my own hair."
- "My PT provided exceptional advice and treatment to facilitate my rehabilitation."
