

Residential Treatment Program

For some people, the use of alcohol or other drugs results in high-risk behaviours, abuse, dependence and subsequent consequences which have a major impact on their lives.

Northern Addictions Centre Residential Treatment is a 20-day intensive treatment program for men and women to learn the tools necessary to live free from alcohol and other drugs.

The full program can be accessed with residential support.

Treatment programming includes:

- Daily interactive workshops and lectures
- Therapeutic group counselling
- A variety of leisure development activities
- Participation in community-based 12-step groups
- A family component is offered every second week (Thursday night and Friday morning)

Referral Information

Please phone our Admissions office or the nearest Alberta Health Services – Addiction and Mental Health office.

Admission requires:

- A completed Residential Treatment Application
- A medical completed by our admission nurse
- An assessment completed by an Addictions Counsellor
- Minimum of five days alcohol/drug and gambling-free prior to admission

Detoxification and early admission can be arranged if required.

Applications will be reviewed by admission staff prior to acceptance into the program.

The Northern Addictions Centre is wheelchair-accessible.
