



West Edmonton Mall

The West Edmonton Mall opened its doors in 1981, and is still the largest shopping mall in North America. Home to over 800 stores, 2 hotels, and 100 different places to eat, the mall also has a number of attractions, including the Galaxyland amusement park, a waterpark, a skating rink, mini-golf, a shooting range, a 24-hour gym, a dinner theatre, and three radio stations. Not only does it get an average of 90,000 visitors per day, the mall is also valued at over \$1 billion.

As if being the biggest mall wasn't enough, many of the attractions are also world record holders, making the West Edmonton Mall a must-see stop for any visitor. Galaxyland is the world's second-largest indoor amusement park, and the waterpark is home to the biggest indoor wave pool in the world.

The mall was founded by the Ghermezian family, who moved to Canada from Iran in 1964 and are known for building many of North America's biggest malls.
