

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Luc Bayard
"the Owner"

RE: Those premises located in Black Diamond, Alberta and municipally described as:
Cool Hand Luc's Treasure Shop
109 Centre Ave W

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) has issued the following Records Of Decision – CMOH Order 04-2021, 25-2020, 26-2020 of the Public Health Act, as may be amended or varied by subsequent Records of Decision, in response to a public health emergency,

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises in contravention of one or more of the above orders of the CMOH and which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The owner/operator was not wearing a mask when speaking to a Public Health Inspector inside the store on January 14th, January 20th, and March 3rd, 2021. The owner/operator was observed speaking with a customer inside the store by the front door without a mask while within 6 feet of the customer on March 3rd, 2021.
- b. No disinfectant was available for use on high-touch surfaces on January 20th and March 3rd, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Ensure that the owner and staff wear a mask that fits securely over the nose and mouth whenever any other person is in the store, except when the owner or staff is consistently behind a barrier deemed acceptable by an Executive Officer.
 - b. Ensure that the owner makes available and uses a disinfectant on high-touch surfaces that has a Drug Identification Number (DIN) and virucidal claim, or use 1000ppm chlorine, or use a disinfectant that is on the approved list of COVID disinfectants from Health Canada.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed immediately.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
