

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: Alimat Ololade Giwa
"the Owner"

RE: The social care facility located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:
Alimat Giwa Ololade – Dayhome
135 Aquila Drive NW

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Evidence indicated that food from an unapproved source may have been served to the children and/or may have cross-contaminated foods served to children.
- b. There was inadequate separation between food intended for the children obtained from approved sources and food obtained from unapproved sources within the facility.
- c. The operator used an unapproved sanitizer, scented Lysol disinfectants, to clean and sanitize food contact surfaces during repackaging, food handling and food preparation of food products in her kitchen.
- d. Uncooked frozen food was stored in a garbage bag in a chest freezer located in the garage.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act, the Institutions Regulation, Alberta Regulation 143/1981 and the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Evidence indicated that food from an unapproved source may have been served to the children and/or may have cross-contaminated foods served to children. Food products such as beef and chicken had no food labels and no receipts available to determine where the food items were purchased. This is in contravention of the Institutions Regulation AR 143/1981 section 28, which states that: in every institution and day care facility, food shall be properly prepared, stored and served under sanitary conditions. This is also in contravention of Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, AR 243/2003 section 2(1), which states: no person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance.
- b. There was inadequate separation between food intended for the children obtained from approved sources and food obtained from unapproved sources within the facility. This is in contravention of the Institutions Regulation AR 143/1981 section 28, which states that: in every institution and day care facility, food shall be properly prepared, stored and served under sanitary conditions. This is also in contravention of Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, AR 243/2003 section 2(1), which states: no person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance.

- c. The operator used an unapproved sanitizer, scented Lysol disinfectants, to clean and sanitize food contact surfaces during repackaging, food handling and food preparation of food products in her kitchen. This is in contravention of the Institutions Regulation AR 143/1981 section 28, which states that: in every institution and day care facility, food shall be properly prepared, stored and served under sanitary conditions.
- d. Uncooked frozen food was stored in a garbage bag in a chest freezer located in the garage. This is in contravention of the Institutions Regulation AR 143/1981 section 28, which states that: in every institution and day care facility, food shall be properly prepared, stored and served under sanitary conditions. This is also in contravention of Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, AR 243/2003 section 2(1), which states: no person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance.

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately Close the above noted premises.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Ensure all foods are from an approved source. Provide receipts verifying the source.
 - b. Develop a food safety plan outlining how the operator will obtain food from approved sources and how they will clean/disinfect kitchen surfaces/dayhome areas.
 - c. Obtain an approved sanitizer such as: unscented bleach sanitizer solution at 100 ppm or quaternary (quats) sanitizer solution at 200 ppm. Instructions on how to prepare sanitizer provided.
 - d. Store food products in food-grade containers or packaging.
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
