

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: Maryuris Estrada Bilbao
"the Owner"

RE: The food establishment located in Alberta and municipally described as:
Be Healthy and Fit - CGY-2164, 504 - 2445 Kingsland Road SE, Airdrie, Alberta T4A
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WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Fruit juices being sold at the Airdrie Culture Fest were made in operator's home kitchen and not made in an approved kitchen.
- b. Operator was in violation of her food permit conditions. Food permit states all food items must be made in an approved kitchen. Operator was selling food made from home kitchen

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Fruit juices being sold at the Airdrie Culture Fest were made in operator's home kitchen and not made in an approved kitchen. This is in contravention of the Food Regulation AR 31/ 2006 section 22(1), which states that; A commercial food establishment must obtain all food that is liable under law to inspection by the Government of Canada or Alberta or by an agency of either from a source that is subject to inspection by that entity.
- b. Operator was in violation of her food permit conditions. Food permit states all food items must be made in an approved kitchen. Operator was selling food made from home kitchen. This is in contravention of the Food Regulation AR 31/ 2006 section 9(1) & (4), which states that; The regional health authority may make the issue or renewal of a permit subject to restrictions on the type of food that, or the manner in which any type of food may be served, manufactured, processed or stored, and any other terms and conditions the authority considers to be appropriate. An operator shall ensure that the terms and conditions of the permit are not contravened.

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Discard all unapproved food items from facility.
 - b. Produce evidence in the form of written/documented permission to rent an approved kitchen.
 - c. Provide a written/documented schedule/frequency of use of the rented permitted kitchen.
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
