ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: Church Fitness Inc. "the Owner"

Sonja Sunny Anne Britton "the Owner"

RE: The cold plunge pool located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as: Church Fitness 88 Crowfoot Terrance NW

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

a. The facility was operating a cold plunge pool without obtaining a permit from Alberta Health Services.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Public Swimming Pools Regulation, Alberta Regulation 204/2014 and the Pool Standards there under exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

a. The facility was operating a cold plunge pool without obtaining a permit from Alberta Health Services. This is in contravention of section 7(1) of the Alberta Public Swimming Pools Regulation Alberta Regulation 204/2014, which states that: No person shall operate a pool without a permit issued in accordance with this section.

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

- 1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
- 2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. An application for a permit must be made to the regional health authority where the pool is located, in the form required by the regional health authority.

3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
