

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: Adriana Stephanie Sein
"the Owner"

RE: The food establishment located in Airdrie, Alberta and municipally described as:
Churrolandyyc-CGY-1982
801 - 7013 Luxstone Square SW

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Operator was in violation of the food handling permit restrictions issued by the Regional Health Authority - Alberta Health Services. Operator was making/heating churros from home-based storage location which was approved to only store and sell prepackaged food items.
- b. Operator was selling food obtained from an unapproved source, out of the AHS approved home-based food storage location. High risk foods such as empanadas, cheesecakes and tamales made in a non-commercial home kitchen were being sold out of location to the public.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Operator was in violation of the food handling permit restrictions issued by the Regional Health Authority - Alberta Health Services. Operator was making/heating churros from home-based storage location which was approved to only store and sell prepackaged food items. This is in contravention of section 9(4) and (5) of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006, which states that an operator must ensure that the terms and conditions of the permit are not contravened and a person who carries on any activity under the purported authority of a permit must comply with the terms and conditions of the permit.
- b. Operator was selling food obtained from an unapproved source, out of the AHS approved home-based food storage location. High risk foods such as empanadas, cheesecakes and tamales made in a non-commercial home kitchen were being sold out of location to the public. This is in contravention of section 22(1) of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006, which states that a commercial food establishment must obtain all food that is liable under law to inspection by the Government of Canada or Alberta or by an agency of either from a source that is subject to inspection by that entity.

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Discard all food prepared in unapproved kitchen
 - b. Identify and acquire an approved kitchen for all preparation of foods to be sold from this mobile. Provide evidence adequate to an Executive Officer that the approved kitchen is available and appropriate for use and that it will be exclusively used for all food preparation for public distribution
3. That, until such a time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
