

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

RE: The food establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:
Floyd's Lechon and Catering
110 - 3208 8 Avenue NE Calgary, Alberta T2A 7V8

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Pigs were being dressed and cooked in an unapproved rural facility and transported in unrefrigerated trucks to the approved location at 110 – 3208 8 Ave NE for further processing.
- b. Trays of chicken were observed sitting out at room temperature. The chicken was measured at 16 degrees C.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Pigs were being dressed and cooked in an unapproved rural facility and transported in unrefrigerated trucks to the approved location at 110 – 3208 8 Ave NE for further processing. This is in violation of Section 22(1) of the Food Regulation, which states: "Subject to this section, a commercial food establishment must obtain all food that is liable under law to inspection by the Government of Canada or Alberta or by an agency of either from a source that is subject to inspection by that entity."
- b. Trays of chicken were observed sitting out at room temperature. The chicken was measured at 16 degrees C. This is in violation of Section 25(1)(a)(b) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states that: "All high risk foods must be stored, displayed and transported at a temperature of not more than 4 degrees C or such higher temperature, or not less than 60 degrees C or such lower temperature as an executive officer stipulates under subsection (4)."

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Immediately stop storing, handling, preparing and cooking food products in locations without a food permit from Alberta Health Services.
 - b. Discard all whole pigs and pork related products observed on site. The disposal must be witnessed by a Public Health Inspector with Alberta Health Services.
 - c. Provide copies of the disposal receipts to a Public Health Inspector with Alberta Health Services.
 - d. Submit a Food Safety plan to a Public Health Inspector with Alberta Health Services for review and approval. The Food Safety Plan must comprehensively describe how the business will operate legally to meet demand within the existing approved location. The plan must include, at minimum, details on how raw and cooked pork/pork products will be transported, stored, handled, prepared and cooked.
 - e. Discard all chicken that was observed at 16 degrees C.
3. The work referred to in paragraph 2(b) must be completed by September 4, 2026.
4. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
