

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

**To:** Mayalu Canada Inc.

"the Owner"

Rahul Lama "the Owner"

**RE:** The food establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:

Mayalu – CGY-2021 3825 Fonda Way SE

**WHEREAS** I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have received a report about the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such report disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. A water samples collected on April 24, 2025 indicated the presence of total coliforms and E. coli.
- b. A water sample collected on April 25, 2025 indicated the presence of total coliforms and E. coli.

**AND WHEREAS** such report disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Water samples collected on April 24, 2025 indicated the presence of total coliforms and E. coli. This is in contravention of the Food Regulations, AR 31/2006, section 17 (1) (f) (i), which states that: An operator must ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment is supplied with hot and cold running water that is safe for human consumption and available in quantities sufficient to meet the needs of the commercial food establishment.
- b. Water samples collected on April 25, 2025 indicated the presence of total coliforms and E. coli. This is in contravention of the Food Regulations, AR 31/2006, section 17 (1) (f) (i), which states that: An operator must ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment is supplied with hot and cold running water that is safe for human consumption and available in quantities sufficient to meet the needs of the commercial food establishment.

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

## NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
- 2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Address structural deficiencies associated with the fresh water holding tank.
  - b. Shock chlorinate the water system then flush completely.
  - c. Fill the fresh water holding tank with water from a safe, indoor source.
  - d. Submit bacteriological water sample from the food truck to the Provincial Laboratory.
- 3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; and the water sample in 2(d) is satisfactory, the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of receipt of the report and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
