

## **ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER**

**RE:** Those premises located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:  
Purple Perk Coffee Market at 2212 4 Street SW

**WHEREAS** I, an **Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) has issued the Record Of Decision – CMOH Order 25-2020 and CMOH Order 26-2020 of the Public Health Act, in response to a public health emergency,

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises in contravention of the above orders of the CMOH and which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Dining tables on the outdoor patio and inside the dining room were less than 2 meters apart. Patrons were seated directly back-to-back and side-by-side on the patio and inside the dining room.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Remove as many tables and chairs as necessary from the outdoor patio and indoor dining area so that there is at least 2 meters of distance between each dining party.
  - b. Tables and chairs that cannot be moved must be clearly demarcated so that there is a minimum of 2 meters between each dining party. Alternatively, install appropriate physical barriers that exceed the breathing zone by a wide margin.
  - c. Complete the Relaunch Plan Template, located in appendix A of the Government of Alberta General Relaunch Guidance. Provide the details of all risk mitigation measures to be implemented to prevent the transmission of COVID-19. The Relaunch Plan Template must be submitted to an Alberta Health Services Executive Officer for review.
  
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1(a,b) shall be completed immediately. The work referred to in paragraph 1(c) shall be completed by September 14, 2020.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
