

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

RE: The food establishment located in Banff, Alberta and municipally described as:
The Banff Centre, Sally Borden Main Kitchen, HUB / Dish room

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Fly infestation was noted around mop sink, around dishwasher, in area for cleaning carts, on walls of dish area, and by sink in staff cafeteria during inspections on March 25/2015, February 22/2016, August 17/2016, May 1/2017, and August 25/2017.
- b. Tiles were broken between wall and floor joint in cart washing area causing area to be difficult to clean and dry out adequately.
- c. Equipment such as garbage cans and dishwasher curtains were built up with organic debris and no longer easily cleanable.
- d. Some pooling water was noted on the floor around the dishwasher and in the cart washing area.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Fly infestation was noted around mop sink, around dishwasher, in area for cleaning carts, on walls of dish area, and by sink in staff cafeteria. This is in violation of Section 21(1) of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 which states that: The commercial food establishment and any surrounding area, premises or facilities supporting the commercial food establishment must be kept free of pests and of conditions that lead to the harbouring or breeding of pests.
- b. Tiles were broken between wall and floor joint in cart washing area causing area to be difficult to clean and water to pool in area. This is in violation of Section 21(1) of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 which states that: The commercial food establishment and any surrounding area, premises or facilities supporting the commercial food establishment must be kept free of pests and of conditions that lead to the harbouring or breeding of pests.
- c. Equipment such as garbage cans and dishwasher curtains were built up with organic debris and no longer easily cleanable. This is in violation of Section 21(1) of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 which states that: The commercial food establishment and any surrounding area,

premises or facilities supporting the commercial food establishment must be kept free of pests and of conditions that lead to the harbouring or breeding of pests.

- d. Some pooling water was noted on the floor around the dishwasher, in the mop sink, and in the cart washing area. This is in violation of Section 21(1) of the Food Regulation AR 31/2006 which states that: The commercial food establishment and any surrounding area, premises or facilities supporting the commercial food establishment must be kept free of pests and of conditions that lead to the harbouring or breeding of pests.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Submit a detailed plan to mitigate the fly population acceptable to an executive officer of Alberta Health Services, Calgary Zone.
 - b. Provide the most recent and ongoing records from your Pest Control Operator related to eliminating the fly population.
 - c. Increase cleaning of dish area to ensure flies do not have access to organic matter or wet areas.
 - d. Replace equipment such as garbage cans and dishwasher curtains that are no longer easily cleanable.
 - e. Maintain the dish area in a clean and dry condition that adequately controls breeding of flies.
 - f. Repair any broken tiles to ensure all building materials are smooth and easily cleanable.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1a. through 1e. shall be completed by September 8, 2017. The work in paragraph 1f. shall be completed by September 30, 2017.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
