RE: The food establishment located in Calgary, Alberta and municipally described as:
Vattan Grocery & Halal Meats
#12 5269 Memorial Drive SE, Calgary, AB T2A 4V1

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Food observed from an unapproved source.
- b. Cleaning clothes are not submerged in a sanitizer solution when not in use.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Food observed from an unapproved source. This is in contravention of section 22(1) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states that: Subject to this section, a commercial food establishment must obtain all food that is liable under law to inspection by the Government of Canada or Alberta or by an agency of either from a source that is subject to inspection by that entity.
- b. Cleaning clothes are not submerged in a sanitizer solution when not in use. This is in contravention of section 28(2) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states that: A commercial food establishment, all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Cease and remove all food items from unapproved sources.
 - b. Prepare food safe sanitizers during operation, ie, 100 ppm bleach solution, and keep cleaning cloths submerged in sanitizer solution.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed immediately.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
