

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION ORDER TO VACATE

To: Sundre Car Wash Ltd.

Harry Singh "the Owners"

And To: All Occupant(s) of the following Housing premises:

RE: Those housing premises located in Sundre, Alberta and municipally described as:

231 4 Street NW

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The roof has partially collapsed and is open to the environment.
- b. There is water, mold and algae growing in the home.
- c. The front door was not locked and was partially ajar.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The roof has partially collapsed and is open to the environment, which is a violation of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards Section 1(a, d), which states: "The housing premises shall be structurally sound, and repairs or modifications required by the Executive Officer of any structural element of the housing premises may require the design and/or supervision of a professional structural engineer or a Safety Codes Officer."
- b. There is water, mold and algae growing in the home, which is a violation of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards Section 1(c), which states: "Building materials that have been damaged or show evidence of rot or other deterioration shall be repaired or replaced."
- c. The front door was not locked and was partially ajar, which is a violation of the Minimum Housing and Health Standards Section 3(a), which states: "Exterior windows and doors shall be capable of being secured."

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Unfit for Human Habitation**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the occupants vacate the above noted premises on or before July 31, 2024.
- 2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Repair the roof so as to make it structurally sound and weatherproof.
 - b. Remove all the rotted and damaged building materials from inside the house and refurbish the affected interior portions of the house to make it safe to live in.
 - c. Immediately secure the house from unauthorized entry.
- 3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain vacant and secure from unauthorized entry.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
