

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

- To: Akinwumi Oyedele "the Owner"
- **RE:** Those housing premises located in Wetaskiwin, Alberta and municipally described as: 4722 51 Avenue.

WHEREAS I, an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. There are structural concerns with the building because of a previous placement of a hydraulic jack on a vertical beam to support the main floor.
- b. There are significant cracks observed on the exterior foundation of the rental property.
- c. The handrail leading to the basement is not installed.

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Housing Regulation, Alberta Regulation 173/99, and the Minimum Housing and Health Standards exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. There are structural concerns with the building because of a previous placement of a hydraulic jack on a vertical beam to support the main floor. This is in contravention of section 1(a) which states that "The housing premises shall be structurally sound" and Section 1(d) which states that "Repairs or modifications required by the Executive Officer of any structural element of the housing premises may require the design and/or supervision of a professional structural engineer or a Safety Codes Officer (Building Discipline)."
- b. There are significant cracks observed on the exterior foundation of the rental property. This is in contravention of section 1(a) which states that "The housing premises shall be structurally sound" and Section 1(d) which states that "Repairs or modifications required by the Executive Officer of any structural element of the housing premises may require the design and/or supervision of a professional structural engineer or a Safety Codes Officer (Building Discipline)."
- c. The handrail leading to the basement is not installed. This is in contravention of section 3(c)(i) which states that "Inside or outside stairs or porches including all treads, risers, supporting structural members, handrails, guards and balconies, shall be maintained in good repair and shall comply with the requirements of the Alberta Building Code or a Professional Engineer design."

## NOW THEREFORE, I hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Ensure that a qualified licensed structural engineer or Safety Codes Officer assesses the interior building structure in the basement to ensure its structural integrity.
- b. Ensure that a qualified licensed structural engineer or Safety Codes Officer assesses the exterior building foundation to ensure that the building is structurally sound.
- c. Ensure that the basement handrail is properly installed and meets the requirements of the Alberta Building Code or a Professional Engineer design.
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by January 31, 2025, and any documentation outlining the assessments are forwarded to the Executive Officer no later than February 14, 2025.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
