

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

- To: 1123462 Alberta Ltd. Ki Joon Um "the Owners"
- **RE:** The food establishment located in Rimbey, Alberta and municipally described as: Grand Hotel, 4930 51 Street.

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The kitchen space currently has a significant amount of miscellaneous and incompatible items resulting in a disorganized space, thus, increasing the risk of contamination to food, food preparation and making it difficult to clean in hard to reach areas.
- b. The kitchen space is not in a clean and sanitary state to promote safe food preparation. Sections of work surfaces and food equipment were observed to have dust and food debris.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The kitchen space currently has a significant amount of miscellaneous and incompatible items resulting in a disorganized space, thus, increasing the risk of contamination to food, food preparation and making it difficult to clean in hard to reach areas. This is in contravention of section 20(1) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states: "All articles and materials in a commercial food establishment that are not associated with or required for the operation or maintenance of the food areas must be stored separately from the food and the food areas and in a manner that contaminates neither."
- b. The kitchen space is not in a clean and sanitary state to promote safe food preparation. Sections of work surfaces and food equipment were observed to have dust and food debris. This is in contravention of section 28(2) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006 which states: "A commercial food establishment, all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination."

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Ensure all miscellaneous and incompatible items are either removed from the kitchen space or stored away in a manner that does not present a potential risk for food related contamination.
- b. Ensure a thorough cleaning of the food establishment is performed to ensure food equipment and surfaces are in a clean and sanitary state to promote safe food handling/preparation.
- 2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by May 23, 2025.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
