

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: O'Chiese Hospitality LP

"the Owner"

RE: The "pool" located in Red Deer, Alberta and municipally described as:

Red Deer Resort & Casino - Swimming Pool, 3310 50 Avenue

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have received a report about the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such reports disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

a. The microbiological water quality of the pool is not being maintained, as bacteriological analysis has indicated the presence of total coliforms in two consecutive water samples taken on September 17, 2025, and September 24, 2025.

AND WHEREAS such reports disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Public Swimming Pools Regulation, Alberta Regulation 204/2014 and the Pool Standards there under exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

a. The microbiological water quality of the pool is not being maintained, as bacteriological analysis of the water samples has shown the presence of total coliforms in two consecutive water samples. This is in contravention of section 6.2 (b) of the Pool Standards which states "The quality of water in a public swimming pool must be maintained so that the water does not...show the presence of total coliforms in a 100-milliliter sample"

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

- 1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
- 2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Ensure the pool is adequately treated to eliminate the presence of total coliforms and ensure that a satisfactory sample is collected post treatment.

3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of receiving the report and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
