

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Yeoford Community Centre Society
"the Owner"

RE: The food establishment located in Wetaskiwin County, Alberta and municipally described as: Yeoford Community Centre, 465076 Range Road 31

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have received a report about the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such report disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The drinking water supply may be unsafe for human consumption as evidenced by the detection of Total Coliforms and E.coli, in one bacteriological sample collected on August 25, 2026 – (Total Coliforms – PRESENT and E.coli - PRESENT).

AND WHEREAS such report disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code and the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The drinking water supply may be unsafe for human consumption as evidenced by the detection of Total Coliforms and E.coli, in one bacteriological sample collected on August 25, 2026 – (Total Coliforms – PRESENT and E.coli - PRESENT), which is in contravention of the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation Section 11, which states "Where a person provided a source of water that the person intends to be used or realizes or ought to realize will be used by the public for human consumption, the person shall ensure that the water is potable." This is also in contravention of the Food Regulation Section 17(1)(f), which states "An operator must ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment is (i) supplied with hot and cold running water that is safe for human consumption and available in quantities sufficient to meet the needs of the commercial food establishment."

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Implement and post the Boil Water Advisory protocols immediately.
 - b. Diligently pursue the disinfection and any repairs to the water well that are necessary.
 - c. Take and submit 2 water well samples, for bacteriological purposes, 24 hours apart and have Satisfactory results in order to receive a Notice of Compliance.

2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by September 11, 2026.

The above conditions were noted at the time of receipt of the report and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
