

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

To: Chunning Chen Ya Yi Liu "The Owner"

- And to: Harshminder Malhi Seema Surinder Malhi Priya Malhi "The Operator"
- **RE:** The food establishment located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as: 1417 88A Street SW, Edmonton, Alberta, T6X 1J7

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

a. A commercial food operation is operating without a valid and subsisting food handling permit from Alberta Health Services, which is in contravention of Section 3(1) (a) (b) which states that no person shall operate a food establishment unless the person is an operator who holds a valid and subsisting permit for the operation of the food establishment, and the food establishment is identified on the permit as approved by the regional health authority that issued the permit.

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed.**

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

- 1. That the Owner and Operator immediately close the above noted premises.
- 2. That the Owner and Operator immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Obtain a valid food handling permit from Alberta Health Services.
 - b. Cease all advertising of the commercial food services, including on business website, delivery service websites and social media until a valid food handling permit from Alberta Health Services is obtained.
- 3. That, until such time as the work referred to in paragraph 2 is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services, the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
