

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

RE: Bubba's Food Services, located at 4710 Gateway Blvd., Edmonton

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Full destruction due to fire.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Regulations there under exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Violation a. is in violation of the Nuisance and General Sanitation, Sec. 2(1), which states No person shall create, commit or maintain any condition which is or may become injurious or dangerous to public health, or may hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease.
- b. Violations a. is in contravention of Sections 17(1) & 19 of the Food Regulation which state, "An operator shall ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment
 - (a) is of sound construction and in a good state of repair,
 - (b) is so designed as to facilitate the effective cleaning and sanitizing of it and all equipment, utensils and surfaces with which food comes into contact, in it,
 - (c) is so designed as to ensure the safe and sanitary handling of food in it" and "A person shall not operate a food establishment unless
 - all the requisite plans and specifications referred to in section 16 for the commercial food establishment have been approved by the executive officer,
 - it is constructed and maintained in accordance with that approval."

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted business.
2. That the owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Repair all fire, smoke and water damage. Thoroughly clean and sanitize the entire facility. Ensure that the all repairs are done in accordance with the requirements of the Alberta Building Code and the Alberta Public Health Act
 - b. Discard any food that has become contaminated or is otherwise unfit for human consumption.
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; **the above noted premises shall remain closed.**

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
