

## **ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE**

**RE:** The food establishment located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:  
Noorish Café, 8430 109 Street, Edmonton, Alberta, T6J 1E2

**WHEREAS** I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The food facility was doing food preparation and storing food in an apartment located at 8430 109 Street without a valid Food Handling Permit

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted food establishment, namely:

- a) Violation [a] is in contravention of Section 3(1) of the Food Regulation which states, "No person shall operate a food establishment unless:  
the person is an operator who holds a valid and subsisting permit for the operation of a food establishment, and the food establishment is identified on the permit as approved by the regional health authority that issued the permit."

**AND WHEREAS**, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately Close the above noted food establishment.
2. That the owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Complete an application form for a Food Handling Permit.

- b. Complete all the requirements listed on the attached Food Establishment Health Approval Checklist
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted food establishment shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
