

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER NOTICE OF CLOSURE

RE: The food establishment located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as: The bowling area bar beverage station inside of Gateway Entertainment Center o/a Gateway Lanes, 3414 Gateway Blvd NW

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The handsink in the bowling beverage bar area was plumbed in such a way that the dirty water backed up into the adjacent drinking ice cube storage basin and beverage lines. The dirty water entering ice storage contaminated the ice stored for human consumption.
- b. The ice storage basin drainage was leaking dirty water underneath the basin.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Violations [a and b] are in contravention of Sections 17(1) & 19 of the Food Regulation, which state:
"An operator shall ensure that, before operation of the commercial food establishment commences, the commercial food establishment
 - (a) is of sound construction and in a good state of repair,
 - (b) is so designed as to facilitate the effective cleaning and sanitizing of it and all equipment, utensils and surfaces with which food comes into contact, in it,
 - (c) is so designed as to ensure the safe and sanitary handling of food in it"

AND

- "A person shall not operate a food establishment unless
 - (a) all the requisite plans and specifications referred to in section 16 for the commercial food establishment have been approved by the executive officer,
 - (b) it is constructed and maintained in accordance with that approval."

AND WHEREAS, by virtue of the foregoing, the above noted premises are hereby declared to be **Closed**.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately close the above noted premises.
2. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Repair the handsink to ensure that it drains into enclosed approved plumbing and does not back up or cause contamination into any other sink or plumbing area. Repair the leaking plumbing or other sources of leaks from the compartment sinks. Repair the indicated defects in the plumbing, drains, and/or sanitary drainage systems. Such systems include drains, fixtures, stacks, traps, and vents. Ensure that plumbing and drainage systems are maintained in compliance with the Alberta Plumbing Code and any other associated regulations at all times. Ensure that **ALL** plumbing is maintained in good working condition at all times.
3. That until such time as the work referred to above is completed to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services; the above noted premises shall remain closed.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
