

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Claudia Gonzalas
Edson Sustaita
La Granja Foods

RE: Those premises located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:
The Farm/La Granja Foods, 12323-96 Street, Edmonton

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Operating a food establishment without a valid permit.
- b. Producing food products in a facility was not approved, or subject to inspection, by a governing agency.
- c. Distributing food products that had been made in a facility that was not subject to inspection by a governing agency.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a) Violation [a] is in contravention of Section 3(1) of the Food Regulation which states: "No person shall operate a food establishment unless
 - a. the person is an operator who holds a valid and subsisting permit for the operation of a food establishment, and
 - b. the food establishment is identified on the permit as approved by the regional health authority that issued the permit."
- b) Violation [b,c] are in contravention of Section 22(1) of the Food Regulation, which states: "Subject to this section, a commercial food establishment must obtain all food that is liable under law to inspection by the Government of Canada or Alberta or by an agency of either from a source that is subject to inspection by that entity."

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Cease and desist the operation of a commercial food establishment until such time as you obtain a valid and subsisting permit for the operation of the commercial food establishment.

- b. Cease and desist the manufacture, sale, or distribution of any food products until such time as you obtain a valid and subsisting permit for the operation of a commercial food establishment

2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be complied with immediately upon receipt of this notice

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
