

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: Liberian Cuisine on Wheels Ltd.

RE: The food establishment located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:
Liberian Cuisine on Wheels, 8405 118 Ave NW, T5B 0S6

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer of Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The low-temperature mechanical chemical dishwasher was not adequately sanitizing dishes. Following numerous cycles and previous attempts, the rinse water tested at 0ppm chlorine as verified with chemical test strips.

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The low-temperature mechanical chemical dishwasher was not adequately sanitizing dishes. Following numerous cycles and previous attempts, the rinse water tested at 0ppm chlorine as verified with chemical test strips. This is a contravention of Section 28(1) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006, which states that: "A commercial food establishment must have all the facilities, equipment and utensils that are necessary to ensure its safe operation and maintenance" and Section 28(2) of the Food Regulation, AR 31/2006, which states that: "A commercial food establishment, all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination."

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
 - a. Repair or replace the low-temperature mechanical chemical dishwasher. The final rinse solution must show an approved sanitizer concentration of 100ppm chlorine. Alternatively, the dishwasher may be replaced with 3-compartment sink that is large enough to accommodate and properly wash, rinse, and sanitize the largest piece of equipment or use of a 2-compartment sink on condition that there are no reusable customer utensils.

2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by June 12, 2026.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
