

## **ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER**

**RE:**           The food establishment located in St. Albert, Alberta and municipally described as:  
**Pillar Grove Estate - 106 - 18 Rayborn Crescent, T8N 4B1**

**WHEREAS** I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the **Public Health Act**, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Foods were produced in an unapproved facility without a valid and subsisting food handling permit from Alberta Health Services. A food safety plan was reviewed, and sufficient controls, documentation and safety measures could not be validated or produced by the operator.

These foods include:

- Halkidiki olives stuffed with pimento
- Halkidiki olives stuffed with lemon
- Halkidiki olives stuffed with almond
- Halkidiki olives stuffed with pickled gherkin
- Halkidiki olives stuffed with garlic
- Halkidiki green olives
- Sliced Kalamata olives
- Sliced Halkidiki olives
- Kalamata olives pitted
- Halkidiki olives pitted
- L'Oca pitted Halkidiki olives
- L'Oca whole Kalamata olives
- Whole Kalamata olives

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Nuisance and General Sanitation Regulation, Alberta Regulation 243/2003 exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. A food safety plan was submitted and reviewed. Sufficient controls, documentation, and safety measures could not be validated or produced by the operator, which is in contravention of Section 2, which states that no person shall create, commit or maintain a nuisance.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Destroy all aforementioned food products; including those products on hold at the warehouse, as well as those on hold at any retail location. These products cannot be donated, sold or offered to the public. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that all products, including at retail locations, are destroyed; either by the retail outlet or owner.
  - b. Provide sufficient evidence of said destruction of indicated products to the satisfaction of an Executive Officer.
  
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by Thursday, June 4, 2026.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
