

## ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

**RE:** Those premises located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally  
described as: Super Flea Market 12011 111 Avenue NW

**WHEREAS** I, an Executive Officer of *AT 1031*

*AT* **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

**AND WHEREAS** the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) has issued the Record Of Decision – CMOH Order 26-2020 of the Public Health Act, in response to a public health emergency,

**AND WHEREAS** such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises in contravention of the above order of the CMOH and which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. Market vendors were observed not complying with the CMOH Orders to ensure 2 metre distancing between individuals at all times. Market vendors were observed not wearing masks, not wearing masks in an effective manner, not keeping a 2 metre physical distance from the members of the public or not staying behind physical barriers when individuals are within 2 metres.

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:
  - a. Ensure vendors are wearing masks in an effective manner when they are working at a booth, or
  - b. Install appropriate, effective protective barriers at the booths where the vendors are unable to wear the mask, or
  - c. Ensure adequate (at least 2 metre) distancing is occurring using physical means (tables, ropes or cords, or other physical means) between the vendor and a member of the public.

- d. Ensure that effective face mask wearing, physical distancing, and effective barriers are maintained by all individuals during operation of the market.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1a-d shall be completed **before the vendor is permitted to operate.**

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
