

ORDER OF AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER

To: TipTop Foods Ltd.
Shakir Hussain

RE: The food establishment located in Edmonton, Alberta and municipally described as:
TipTop Foods 152, 550 Clareview Road

WHEREAS I, an **Executive Officer** of **Alberta Health Services**, have inspected the above noted premises pursuant to the provisions of the Public Health Act, RSA 2000, c. P-37, as amended;

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following conditions exist in and about the above noted premises which are or may become injurious or dangerous to the public health or which might hinder in any manner the prevention or suppression of disease, namely:

- a. The hand sink and the three compartment sink in the meat processing area are not draining properly.
- b. Food safety training requirements were not met (for 5 or fewer food handlers working on the premises).

AND WHEREAS such inspection disclosed that the following breaches of the Public Health Act and the Food Regulation, Alberta Regulation 31/2006 and the Food Retail and Foodservices Code exist in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. Violation [a] is in contravention of section 28(1), 28(2) and 28(3) of the Food Regulation which states, "(1) A commercial food establishment must have all the facilities, equipment and utensils that are necessary to ensure its safe operation and maintenance. (2) A commercial food establishment, all equipment and utensils in it and all surfaces in it with which food comes into contact must be maintained in a sanitary condition and, without limiting the foregoing, must be washed and sanitized in a manner that removes contamination. (3) All equipment and utensils in a commercial food establishment must be (a) kept in good working order and condition, and (b) maintained in a manner that ensures the safe and sanitary handling of food."
- b. Violation [b] is in contravention of section 31(1) of the Food Regulation which states, "(1) A person operating a commercial food establishment must, at any time when there are 5 or fewer food handlers working on the premises, ensure that at least one individual who has care and control of the commercial food establishment holds a certificate issued by the Minister confirming that individual's successful completion of a food sanitation and hygiene training program or a document that the Minister considers equivalent to such a certificate."

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby **ORDER** and **DIRECT**:

1. That the Owner immediately undertake and diligently pursue the completion of the following work in and about the above noted premises, namely:

- a. The 3 compartment sink and the hand sink in the meat processing area must be properly plumbed at all times, and be able to adequately drain.
 - b. Provide proof that the requirements for food safety training outlined in section 31 of the Food Regulation is met.
2. The work referred to in paragraph 1 shall be completed by the following deadlines:
Item a must be completed before September 28th, 2017.
Item b must be completed before October 19th, 2017.

The above conditions were noted at the time of inspection and may not necessarily reflect all deficiencies. You are advised that further work may be required to ensure full compliance with the Public Health Act and regulations, or to prevent a public health nuisance.
